Digital retinal imaging is a relatively new technology that allows instant viewing of the images by the doctor. This technology helps us develop baseline images of the back of the eye. We can then compare future images and observe any abnormal changes. This test has proven to help detect many vision threatening conditions, such as glaucoma, macular degeneration, diabetic retinopathy or changes from high blood pressure or cholesterol.

This photo is especially important for patients 65 years old or older, diabetics, patients experiencing floaters, and for women who are nursing or pregnant.
